Over the period of the term for Chairman for Derek Mowlds commencing from May 2011 to May 2013, there has been a continued strong interest in obtaining professional status in the industry within the Republic of Ireland and this appears to correlate to the economic climate and need for professional qualification when competition is high for job opportunities.

2.0 Summary

During the last year there has been a total of four professional interviews taken place with a further one due to take place over the summer months known to date.

The number of applicants for professional interview has significantly decreased from the same period 2011/2012 with four now from eleven previously. Of the four applicants, there the following levels of membership were applied for:

- ACIBSE None.

Of all those applicants interviewed, all were successful, so an excellent pass rate.

7. Branch Almoner's Report:

Almoners Report, CIBSE RoI AGM 25th April 2013

The Benevolent Fund is eighty years in existence this year and has been helping some clients for nearly half that time. During 2012/13 the Benevolent Fund received a considerable increase in requests for help from members who are suffering from illness, redundancy, or other financial difficulties. While the fund endeavours to respond to these requests some of the traditional sources of financial support from the building services from the professions and industry have been reduced or cancelled due to the financial constraints.

The mains sources of income to the fund being:

- a. Voluntary contribution from members in conjunction with their subscription £ 5.00 at present.
- b. Fund raising events organised by the branches. The RoI branch has made a contribution of £1,000.00 from the proceeds of the Annual Christmas lunch for the last couple of years.
- c. The interviewers fees from the professional interviews in Ireland have traditionally been donated to the fund but as the interviews have fallen off in 2012/13 these amounts have reduced significantly.
- d. Occasional legacy left by members in their wills.
- e. Contributions from the industry or professions

The trustees and almoners of the fund meet in CIBSE headquarters in Balham every three months to consider requests from help from new applicants and to review the clients in receipt of ongoing assistance. The next meeting is scheduled for the middle of May.

Requests for assistance are initially submitted to Balham and are then referred to the local almoner to meet the individual and get more details of the individual case. The support often means the difference between recipients being able to carry out essential repairs or a contribution to a motorised wheelchair at the cost of a few hundred pounds or going without.
