The SEAI Energy Awards recognise and reward excellence in all aspects of energy efficiency and renewable energy. The Awards continuously showcase the organisations, communities and individuals who are leading in smart energy solutions and practices.

Large Business – Exemplary energy management

This award is aimed at organisations with an energy spend of over €0.5 million that have demonstrated achievement in energy efficiency and renewable energy over a number of years. Activities might include energy retrofits, process improvements, low energy building projects, or use of renewable technologies, and must include implementing a structured energy management system.



Small and Medium Business – Exemplary energy management

This award is aimed at small to medium businesses with an energy spend under €0.5 million, or with less than 250 employees, that go beyond best practice in energy efficiency and renewable energy. Projects demonstrating low-energy buildings and effective use of renewable technologies are also encouraged.



Energy Team or Energy Manager of the Year

This award celebrates individuals or teams in the public, private or voluntary sectors, who have demonstrated long term leadership and ambition in implementing energy management, resulting in multiple significant benefits for their organisation.



Public Sector – Leadership

This award is aimed at public sector organisations that have demonstrated a history of achievements in energy efficiency and renewbale energy.

Activities might include energy retrofits, process improvements, low energy building projects, or use of renewable technologies, and must include implementing a structured energy management programme.



The Categories

The eight categories are open to individuals, groups or organisations, public and private sector, from either the Republic of Ireland or Northern Ireland. Entries can include any combination of electricity, heat or transport initiatives.

Sustainable Energy Community

This award is aimed at community partnerships, groups and organisations leading change and championing sustainable energy at local level. Activities might include energy retrofits, renewable energy upgrades, behavioural change initiatives or development of an energy master plan.

Buildings

This award recognises organisations who have implemented sustainable and low carbon approaches through design, construction and management of buildings. Applications are welcome from new build or substantial retrofit projects, in residential or commercial settings.





Research and Innovation

This award is aimed at companies, research performing organisations or public sector/ semi-state bodies involved in impactful energy research and innovation. Projects will focus on energy technologies, processes or systems that will contribute significantly to Ireland's clean energy future. This winner will receive a €10.000 bursarv.



This award recognises organisations who have developed large-scale renewable installations, services or products or other innovations that have had a substantial impact on Ireland's energy transition. Entries should represent a striking achievement in the development and deployment of renewable energy at scale in Ireland.





What makes a winning entry?

Winning entries will go well beyond the norms of sustainable energy best practice, excelling in some or all of these areas:

- Achieving significant energy demand reduction or clean energy deployment
- High levels of innovation
- Achieving multiple or tangible benefits
- Robust implementation approach
- Strong potential for replication
